

Getting to Newark from Manhattan

- 1 Newark Pennsylvania Station
- 2 Newark Broad Street Station
- 3 Newark Museum
- 4 Courtyard by Marriott Hotel

The fastest way to get to the museum is a New Jersey Transit train from NY Penn Station to **Newark Broad Street** (20 mins). Then it's a 10 min. walk to the museum or you can take the Light rail (Orange Line) one stop to Washington Park Station/Harriett Tubman Square. There are no taxis at Broad Street. Purchase light rail tickets before boarding.

Another option is to take the New Jersey Transit train from NY Penn to Newark Pennsylvania Station then get a taxi (~\$15), UBER or take the light rail (Orange Line, 5 stops). Note: the light rail goes up to Broad Street Station before it turns and heads back down and stops at Washington Park Station/Harriett Tubman Square.

The third option is to take the PATH to Newark Penn Station – this is the slowest option. The PATH train from the World Trade Center does not require changing trains.



Download the NJ Transit app to purchase tickets and save time.

If you are 60 or over you qualify for half-price Senior fair on NJ Transit.
